TITHE MAPS AND AWARDS

Their creation and content

Tithe awards and maps or, to give them their official title, tithe rent-charge apportionment awards and maps, are among our most versatile and useful historical documents and form an important source for many aspects of local, economic and family history.

They were created as a result of the Tithe Commutation Act of 1836 which replaced the payment of tithes with a rent-charge apportioned between the landowners in a 'tithe district', which was usually a parish but could also be one or more townships. Originally, tithes were a tenth of all produce of the land which people had to surrender in order to produce a living for the incumbent of their parish church. There were two types of tithe: great or rectorial tithes of corn, hay, wool and lamb; and small or vicarial tithes of cows, calves, foals, poultry, bees or anything else which an incumbent could reasonably claim as titheable.

Under the Tithe Commutation Act, owners of land and tithes in a parish could voluntarily agree a sum to be paid in lieu of tithes for the whole parish. Once this agreement was confirmed by the bishop of the diocese, the patron of the living and the Tithe Commissioners, the landowners would appoint a valuer to apportion the agreed rent-charge on each plot of land. This required the drawing up of detailed maps, although sometimes existing maps were used, and schedules of owners and property. From 1 October 1838, compulsory commutation through awards made by assistant commissioners began.

Where tithes had already been commuted and extinguished, for example at the time of enclosure, or had never been paid, for example on former monastic land, there may be no map or schedule at all, or parts of the map may be blank. This absence of information may also affect towns (Stafford St Chad) and the built-up parts of rural parishes. There were also areas, such as parts of the moorlands of northern Staffordshire, where the land was too poor to have become titheable. For some large moorlands parishes (Alstonefield, Leek) there are plans for some townships but not the total parish area. In this guide, maps with substantial parts of the parish or township not shown in detail or described in detail in the award are also indicated, by an asterisk against the date of the award. For the parishes that apparently have no maps and awards at all, a comment has been included if the reason is known (Cheddleton, Edingale, Patshull). No information has been established for Croxden (former monastic land), Ellenhall, Horton (tithes subject to Leek Rectory, the enclosure award relates to a quantity of tithe-free lands), Ipstones, and Okeover.

The maps are often on a scale as large as three or four chains to the inch. The accompanying schedules give details of owners, occupiers, field names or nature of property, area, land use and rent payable for each parcel of titheable land. The state of cultivation is usually given in general terms, such as arable, pasture or meadow, but in a small proportion of apportionments, for example Tixall, the actual crop being grown is specified. The maps and apportionments are usually dated between 1837 and 1852, by which time the tithe commutation process in the whole of the country was largely complete.

Official copies

A copy of each map and award was produced for the Tithe Redemption Commission, the body that administered the whole operation; two other official copies of each were also produced, one for the Diocesan authorities and one for deposit in the appropriate parish chest.

The Tithe Commissioners' copies are now held at The National Archives (Ruskin Avenue, Kew, Richmond, TW9 4DU). Their listing for Staffordshire includes places outside the Diocese of Lichfield for which no official copies are held locally within Staffordshire: Arley, Broom, Clent, Handsworth and Harborne. Official copies of the first three of these are also held at Worcestershire Record Office (County Branch), whilst Birmingham Archives & Heritage Service holds official copies for Harborne including Smethwick, and Handsworth with Perry Barr.

The Diocesan copies covered in this guide (formerly held at Lichfield Record Office) include six First Class maps bearing the seals of the Tithe Commissioners, for Cold Meece, Darlaston, Drayton in Hales, Farewell, Featherstone, and Moreton Say.

The parish copies for Staffordshire parishes have in most cases been deposited by ecclesiastical parishes or civil parish councils. Some parish copies have apparently not survived or their whereabouts is not known. Some may survive but have yet to be deposited.

In terms of access, all parish copies are stored on site at Staffordshire Record Office, as are Diocesan copies for places where the parish copy has not been deposited. These are highlighted in blue text. All other Diocesan copies require advance notice of at least two working days, for both Staffordshire places where a parish copy is deposited, and for all Shropshire places. Exceptions have been made for larger Diocesan maps and awards, or where the parish copy is known to be incomplete or damaged, which are also stored on site.

Unofficial copies

In addition to the three official copies, extra copies were sometimes made for official, administrative or estate purposes or by antiquarians who wanted a copy for historical purposes. The largest series of such copies in Staffordshire is that commissioned by William Salt, now in the Original Collection in the William Salt Library. Although the maps (S.MS.417) were catalogued by Sotheby's as one series, there are in fact two distinct sub-series: a set copied by Edmund Ash and C. B. Ash in 1844 and 1845; and a set copied in the mid-19th century (c1851-1852), and marked with various initials.

Of the copy awards in the William Salt Library (S.MS.430), the items in the first series were certified by the Tithe Commissioners as true and accurate copies, dated 1851-1852. In these copies, the awards (stating the terms of the commutation and listing the tithe-owners), or the agreements have been omitted. This series appears to have been made at the same time as the second sub-series of copy tithe maps.

The second series consists of undated copy schedules which do not include the apportionment of rent-charge in lieu of tithes. It is likely that, where any of these copies were made from the official tithe awards, the last column giving the apportionment of rent-charge was omitted, perhaps because it was considered less useful for research

purposes. These copies appear to have been made at the same time as the first subseries of copy tithe maps created by Edmund Ash and C. B. Ash, but it is unclear whether these two men were also the creators of these copy schedules. Some of these may also have derived from estate or rent surveys, and so would never have included any tithe apportionment.

Other unofficial copies are scattered through estate and family papers, mainly held at Staffordshire Record Office.

USING THIS GUIDE

Arrangement of the guide

This guide consists of two listings, one for Staffordshire places and one for Shropshire places that were within the Diocese of Lichfield at the time of the Tithe Commutation Act (covering northern Shropshire). Penley in Flintshire is also included in this list. Maps and awards for Derbyshire parishes, except those for Chilcote (later Leicestershire) are now held at Derbyshire Record Office at Matlock.

For Staffordshire, the list notes both official and non-official copies of separate tithe awards or maps, as held at Staffordshire Record Office or the William Salt Library. For Shropshire, there is just a single list of Diocesan copies, all of which require advance notice for production. Parish copies for Shropshire are held at Shropshire Archives at Shrewsbury.

Where places sit across parish or county boundaries this is noted. For both lists, the sequence follows ancient parish, with lesser places listed where they are separately distinguished. Cross-references also appear from these individual places to the main parish.

In the series of Diocesan copies, some places may be included in the award of their parent parish, but still have a separate map. Some very small maps are still bound up with the award and have a single reference number. Some places in the list may not have separate official awards or maps at all, but still have separate "copies" in the William Salt Library Original Collection.

Later altered apportionments are not included in this guide. All Diocesan copies of such documents require advance notice for production.

Document reference codes

The Diocesan copies all have reference codes beginning B/A/15. The first sub-number is that of the map and the second is that of the award. The sequence follows an alphabetical sequence by places not ancient parish. In a few cases the map is small enough to have been kept with the award and therefore does not have a separate number. Likewise a few awards were still physically with their maps at the time this guide was published and so do not have a separate number. Maps that have been divided due to their size also share reference numbers. The Archive Service has undertaken an extensive programme to separate most awards from the maps.

The references of copies of maps and copies or schedules of awards in the William Salt Library Original Collection are prefixed S.MS.417/ and S.MS.430/ respectively, but these numbers do not indicate whether or not the copy was made from an official tithe map or award, or from another document such as a rating or town plan..
